

MULTI-GENERATIONAL LEARNING AT THE SHALOM HARTMAN INSTITUTE

For over 20 years, North American community leaders have convened at the beautiful Hartman Institute campus in the heart of Jerusalem to attend the Institute's annual Community Leadership Summer Retreat. Each year, this weeklong seminar deals with a major question facing Judaism in the modern age. This year's theme will be **People of the Body or People of the Book: Embodied Jewish Ethics.**

This summer, we invite you to bring your post-college children or grandchildren to share this unique learning experience with you. For the first time, a cohort of young adults will experience our summer theme through Jewish text study, philosophical and theological debate, and intimate dialogue with senior Hartman scholars. Participants in the young adult cohort will be full members of the Community Leadership Seminar program, enjoying morning lectures, small group seminars, evening programs, and a full-day excursion in Israel together with all the other participants in the CLP Summer Retreat. At the same time, the Shalom Hartman Institute will facilitate meaningful interaction between the young adult participants to explore the particular issues of Jewish identity and ethics in their lives. This young adult group will enjoy a combination of cross-generational study and dialogue with community leaders from across North America, while also meeting and learning with other young Jewish adults.

Special Highlights for young adult participants will include:

- > Cross-generational study and dialogue with community leaders from across North America
- > Small-group discussions for young adults, facilitated by Hartman educators
- > Special break-out seminar study session for young adult participants
- > Professionally facilitated multi-generational dialogue together with parents/ grandparents about Jewish identity in the modern world
- > Special cultural/social event focused on bringing young Americans and Israelis together
